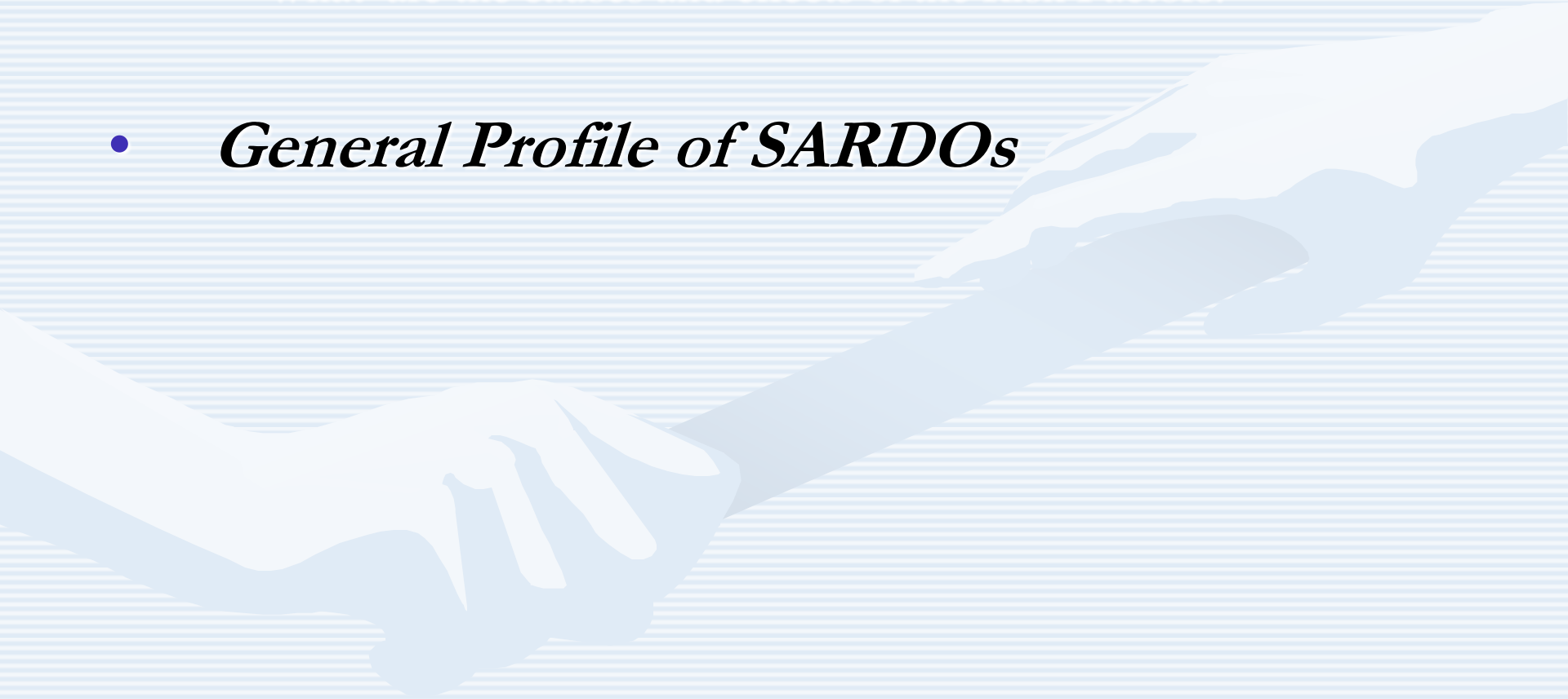

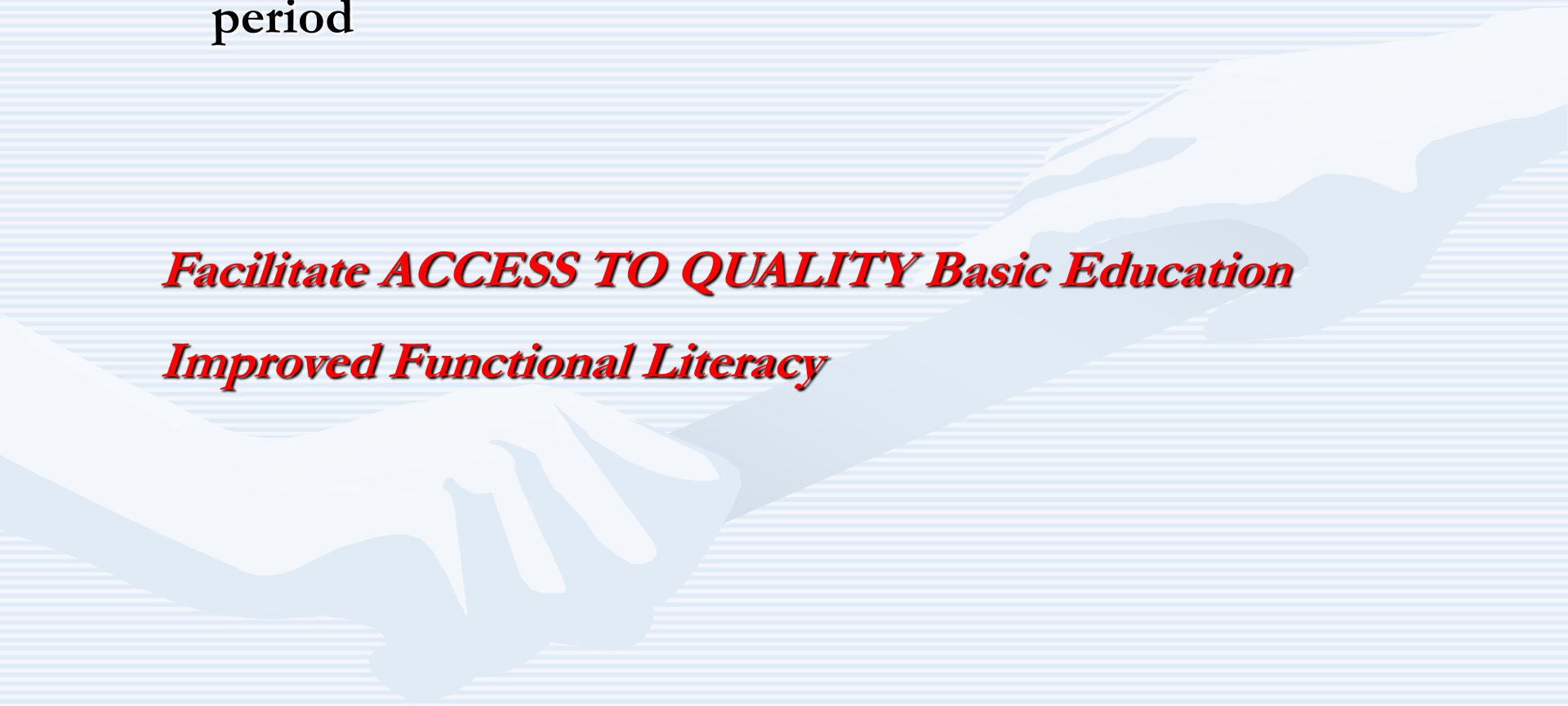


# Goal



# Objectives

- **Contribute to the attainment of the Goal**
  - **What the DORP is expected to achieve during its implementation**
  - **Direct outcome of the DORP interventions**
  - **Must use absolute numbers instead of rate/ percentage for easy tracking of drop-out and counting of SARDOs**
- 
- *Increase participation rate*
  - *Reduce drop out rate*
  - *Increase retention rate*
  - *Increase completion rate*
  - *Raise achievement level of the Students-at-Risk of Dropping Out (SARDO);*
  - *retrieve learners who are out of school*

## *A SMART objective is:*

- **Specific** –clear and relates to the conditions of the school
  - **Measurable** –can be quantified
  - **Attainable** – data related to the objective are available at reasonable cost
  - **Results-oriented** –indicates the product or service, not activity
  - **Time-bound** –has a specific time period

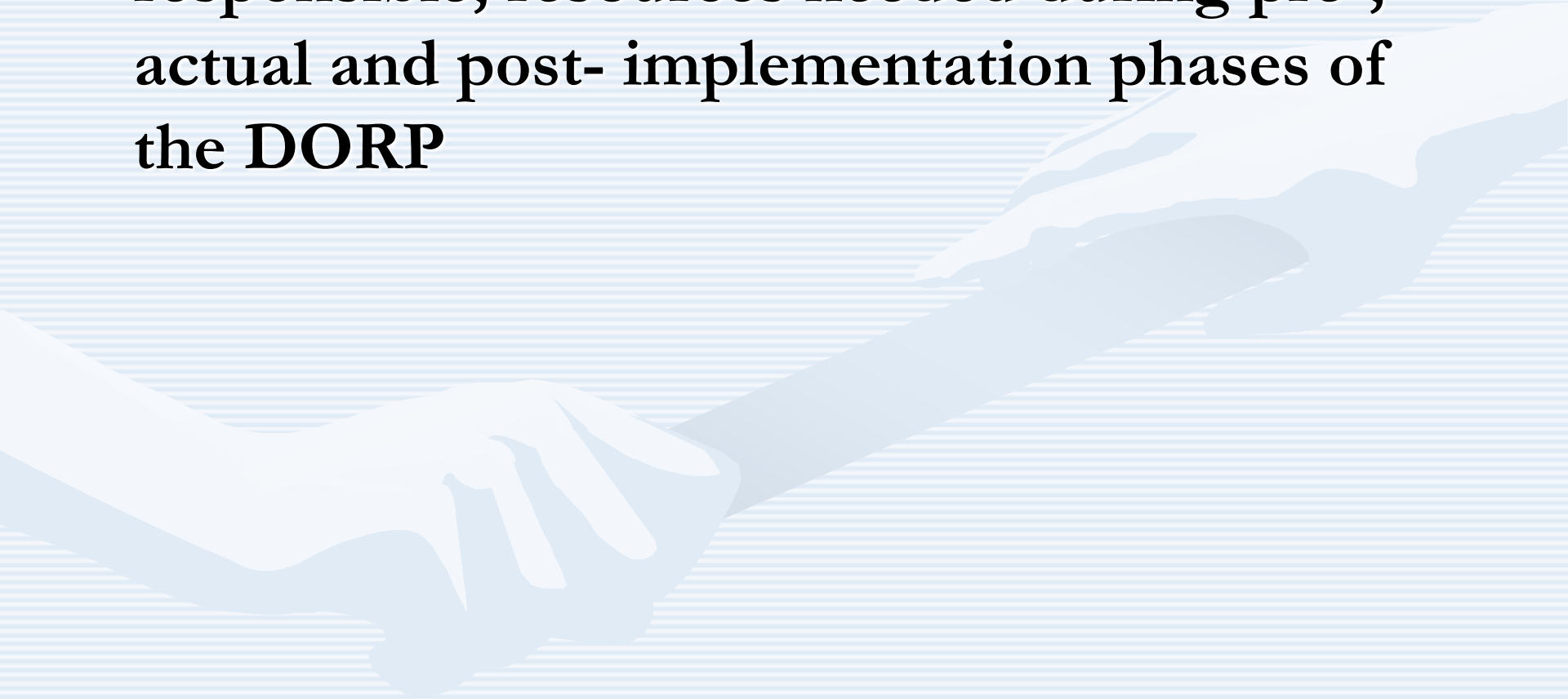

# Implementation Plan


- **Action Steps** – these are the activities to implement a strategy
- **Indicators** - are the measures used to specify the achievement of the program objective or the completion of an activity

# Implementation Plan

- **Means of Verification** – tangible documents that provide evidence of the achievement of the indicators

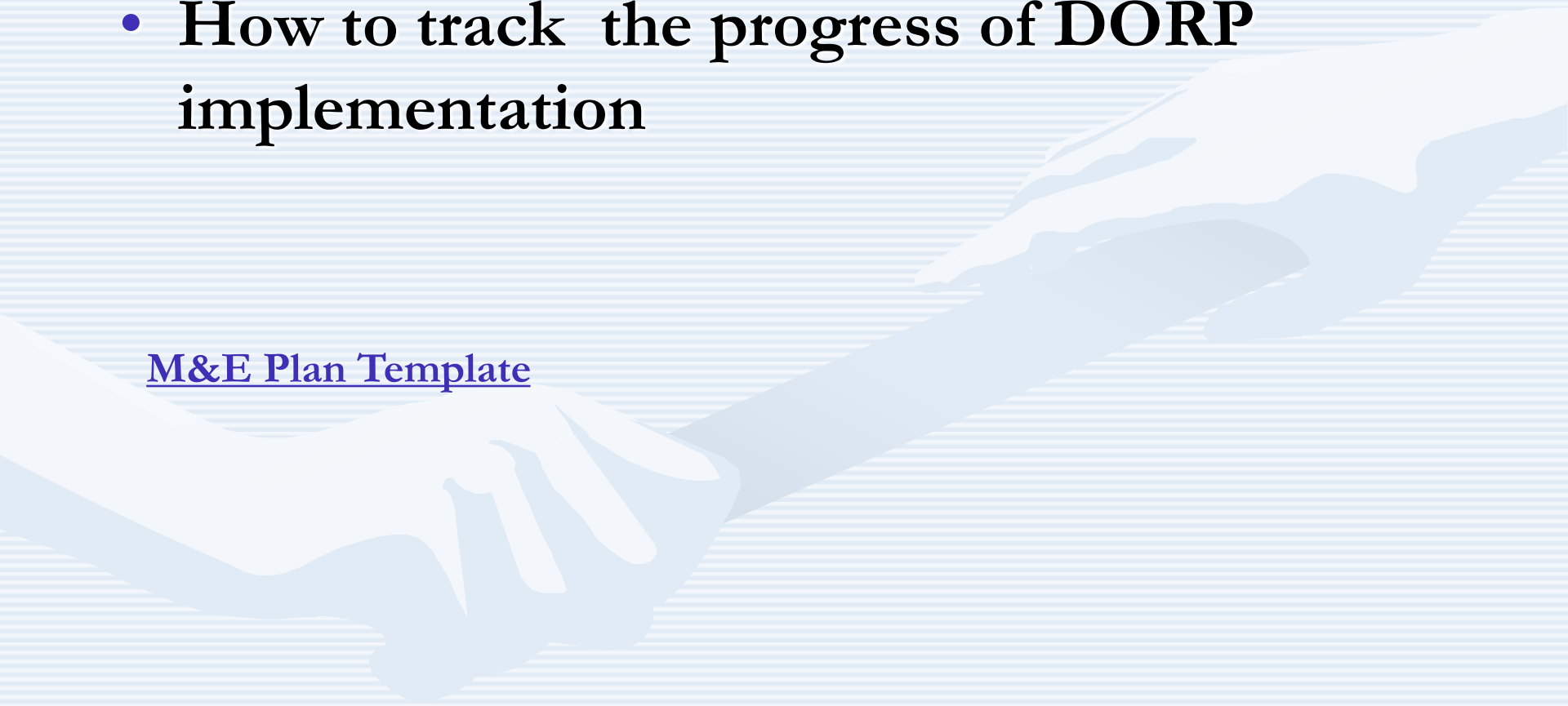
# Implementation Plan

- **Timeframe** – The period to implement a planned activity
  - **Person/s Responsible** – individual/s to implement identified activities
  - **Resource Requirements** – materials required to implement the activity

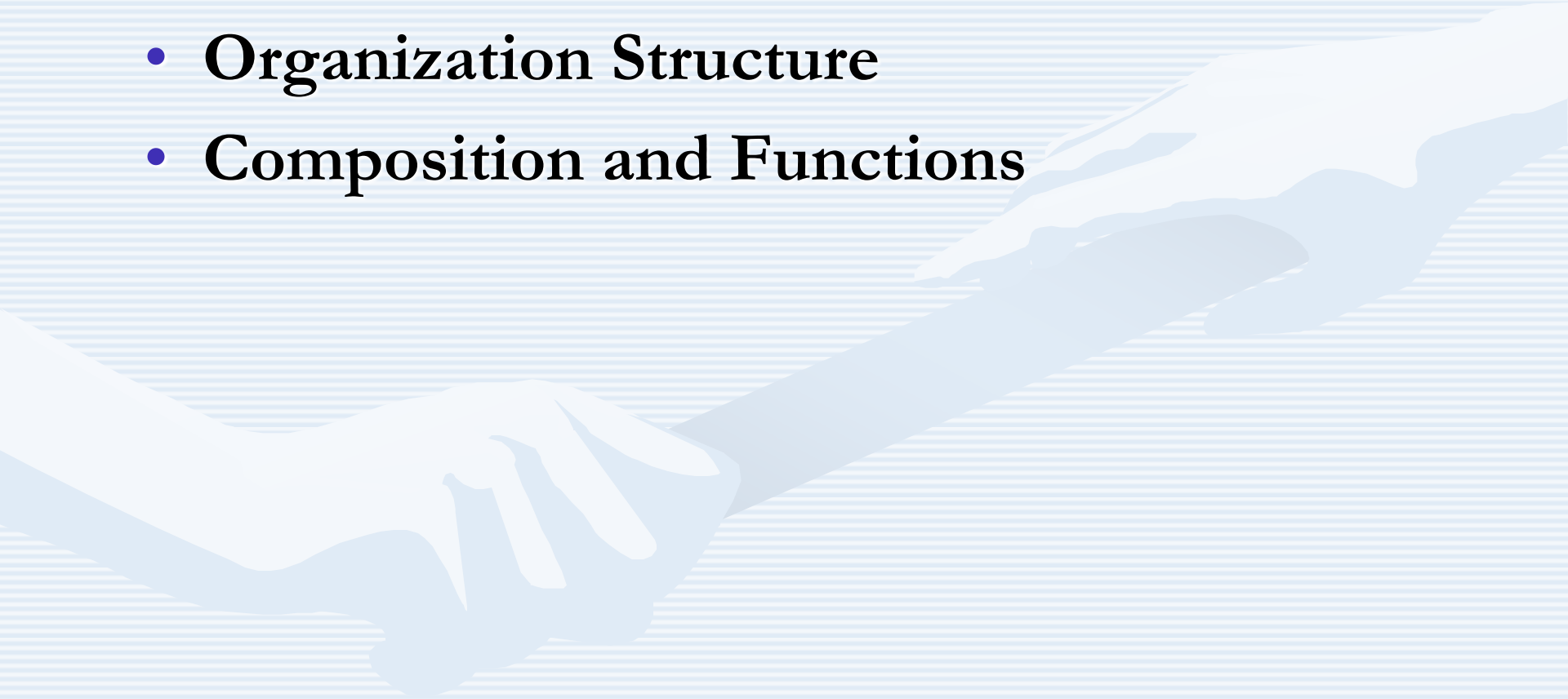

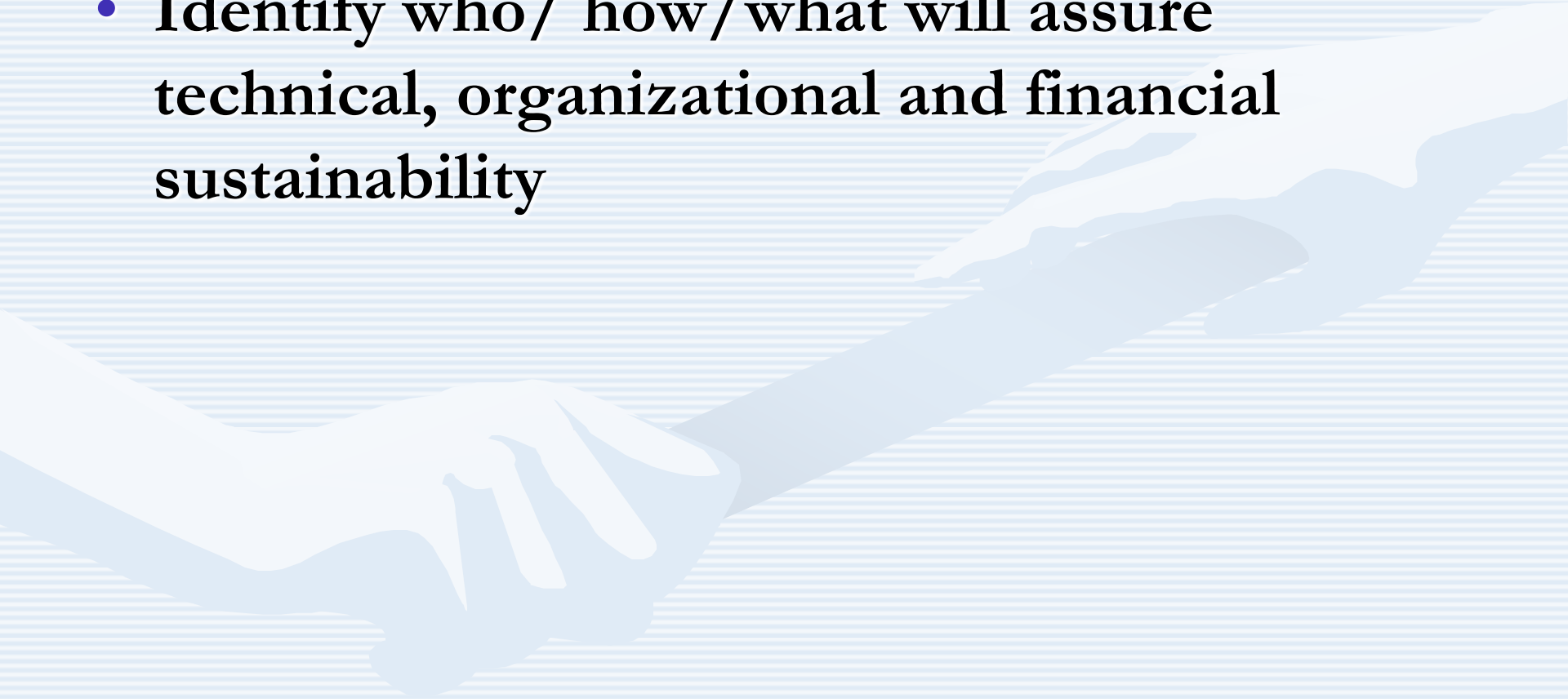

# Sustainability Plan

- Describe the strategies for sustainability
- Identify who/ how/what will assure technical, organizational and financial sustainability



# Examples of sustainability strategies

## Financial

“The MOOE for the activities will be shouldered by...”

## Technical

• “After one year, what do we do next with Mr. SARDO?...”

## Resources

“For next 2 years, we source the EASE modules from....”

## Organization

- “Documenters will be assigned to write the best practices”
- “Teacher- implementers to be assigned will have a minimum remaining tenure of 2-3 years before retirement.”
