




Defining the SCOPE & RELATIONSHIP of the SIP & S-DORP





... is a process by which members of the school community conduct a thorough evaluation of their school's educational programming during the previous school year & develop a written school improvement plan that:

- Establishes the staring point for ongoing evaluation of efforts;
- Provides a road map for school improvement; &
- Unifies independently organized school improvement efforts from various areas of the total school program into a *single, focused process.*

...is the main vehicle through which schools proceed down the path to improvement

> ...should be carefully structured to focus on key goals and strategies which will *lead to greater pupil/student learning* & a *more effective school organization*.



The SIP is a 3-year development plan for the school that integrates the aspirations of the community and stakeholders.



The preparation of the planning document is built on the principles of:

- Shared Governance
- Accountability & Transparency
- Principled
 Engagement .



SIP plans on the following EFA (Education For All) planning areas:

- Provision of Equitable Access
- Quality and Relevance of Basic Education
- Management of Education Services



The planning process is datadriven and as such it is expected that historical, multiyear data on the several planning indicators will be collected



The SIP planning process uses comparable measures of data



To the extent possible, we will use existing planning standards of the department .


Defining the Scope - The DORP

Is a *comprehensive plan* to enable the school to improve/ sustain participation rates, reduce drop-out rates and produce functionally literate learner

It *contains* targets, activities, measures of performance, and resources needed to undertake the plan.







Division Education Development Plan (DEDP)




This is a 6-year unified comprehensive development plan that plans for basic education (formal & alternative learning systems) in the province



- ✓ The D-DORP should be defined by the <u>roles &</u> <u>responsibilities</u> the Division play relative to the schools/CLCs; &
- ✓ The D-DORP is not merely a consolidation of the S-DORPs.



- ✓ The R-DORP is not merely a consolidation of the D-DORPs & S-DORPs.
